- Work with and provide Team Leader constant feedback on testing progress, defect and build status, application readiness, and other testing related metrics
- Work closely with the software development team to ensure proper testing, verification, and validation coverage
- Develop test strategies and plans for performing localization testing
- Help design test plans and test cases for enterprise products
- Perform both guided and exploratory manual test executions following established QA processes
